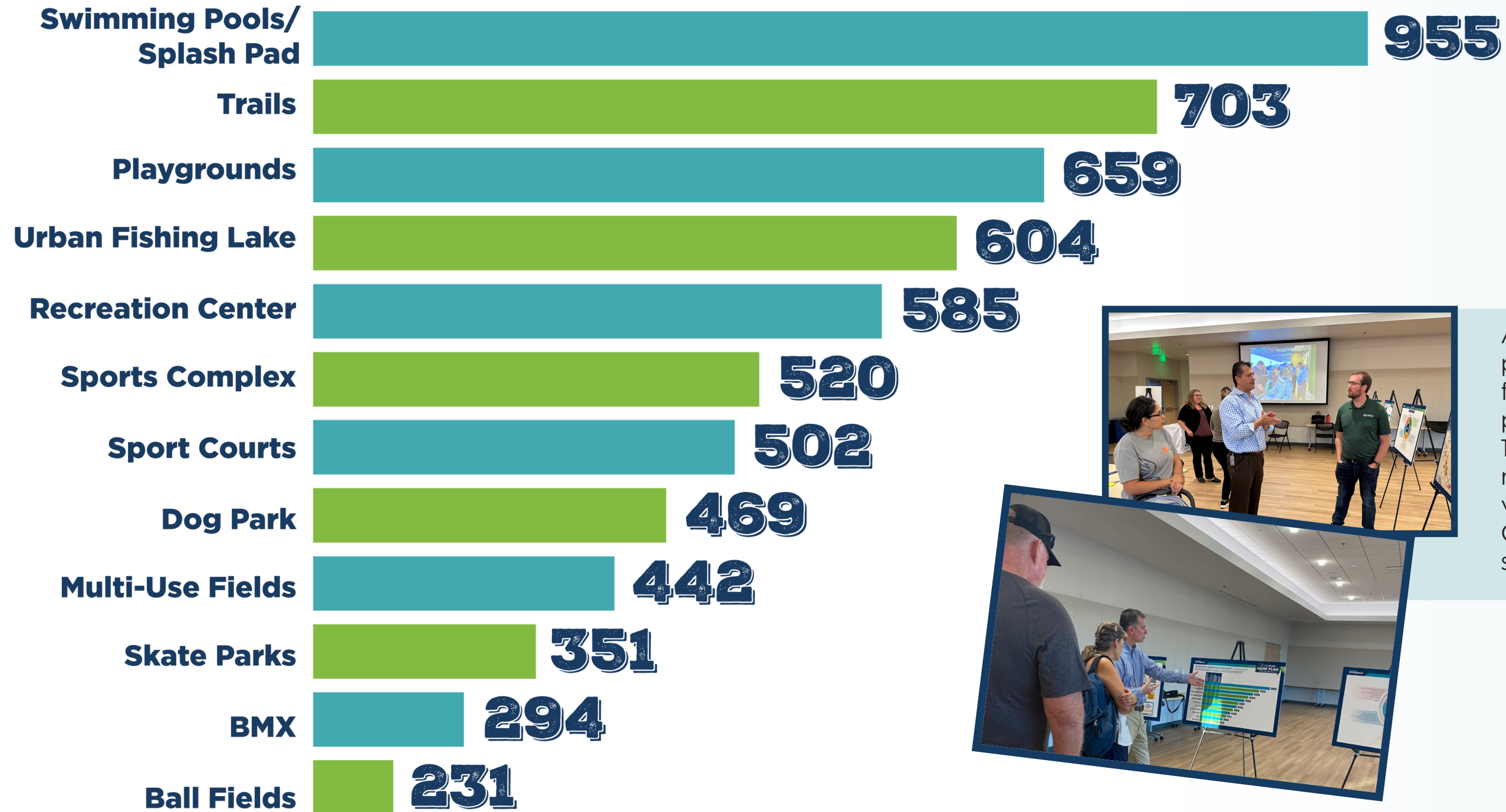


The City's park, trail, and recreation facility level of service was determined by utilizing all of the components of this wheel graphic.

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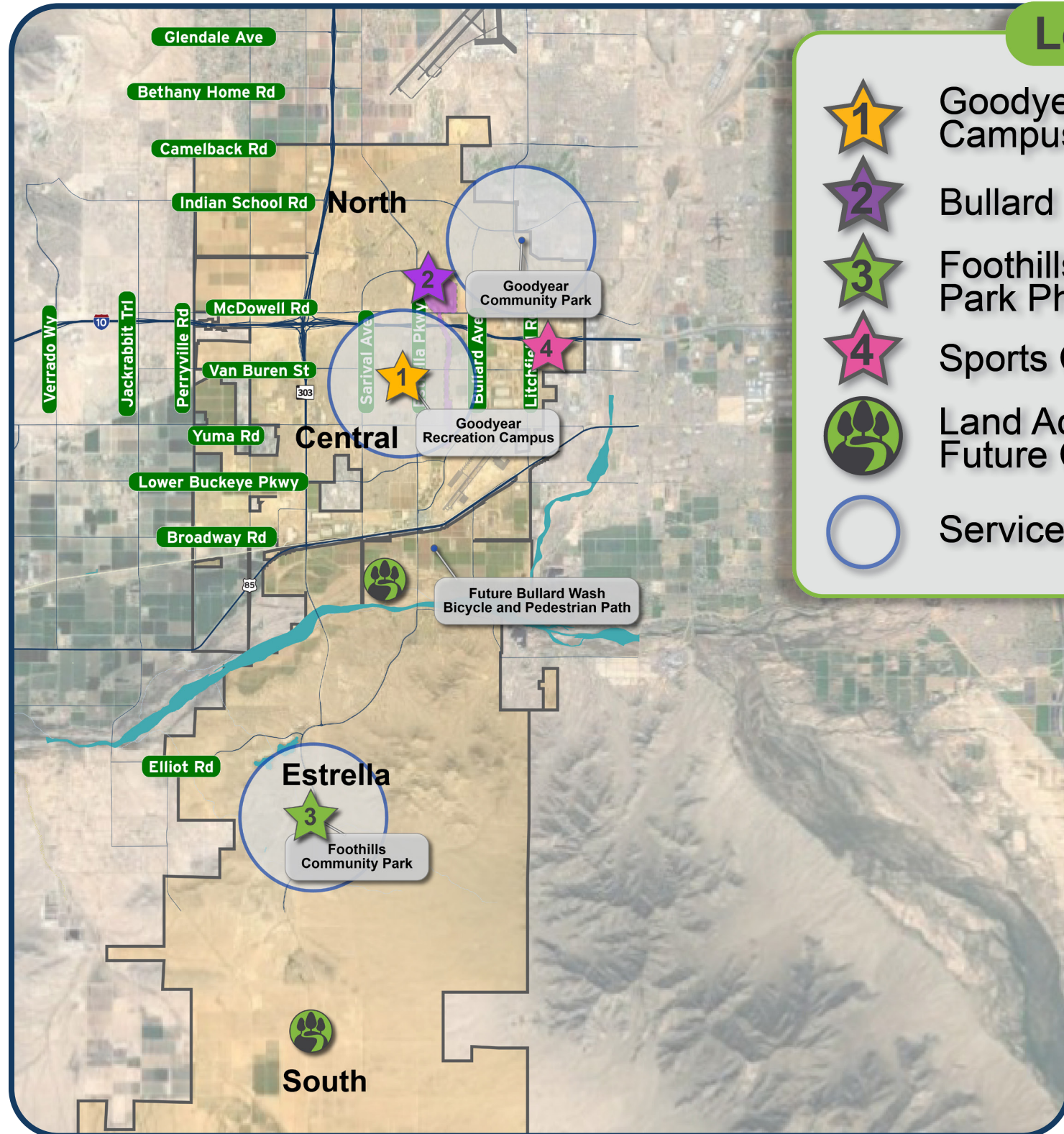


As a result of the public participation program, facility and amenity priorities were determined. These priorities were also mentioned as a need by various other user groups, City leadership, and a statistically-valid survey.
